

CAREGIVING OF THE ELDERLY & DISABLED

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

This training programme is designed to provide and equip participants with appropriate skills and knowledge, confidence, devotion and attitude to become a professional caregiver in the home environment or in specialised institutions such as Clinics, Hospitals, Homes, Orphanages and institutions for the Disabled.

After successful completion of the training programme, caregivers will be able to deliver appropriate support, special attention and assistance to their recipients who may be individuals with special needs, the chronically ill or disabled.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, caregivers can expect to deliver the following:

- Approach to the geriatric patient
- Infection control
- Bed making
- Personal Hygiene and care
- Support Care recipient to meet their needs,
- Nutrition & Basic Medication management
- Transferring, lifting & moving techniques including usage of assistive devices, walking frame, wheelchair and crutches
- Fall prevention
- Health and Safety

PROGRAMME DELIVERY & METHODOLOGY

Programme delivery will be in the form of face-to-face lectures with LCD presentation, case studies, Mauritius case-in-practice, basic exercises and practical sessions.

DURATION

The duration of the programme is twenty (20) hours and will be conducted over five sessions, scheduled on Saturdays, and/or during the weekend from 16:30 to 20:30 in the evening.

PROGRAMME OUTLINE

SN	Main Topics
1	Approach to the Geriatric Patient— Introduction; Physical Changes with ageing; Evaluation; Common Health Problem; Communication; Skill, knowledge and confidence to provide quality care.
2	Infection Control—Understand & Practice Infection Control; Handling the Waste and Linen Properly
3	Bed Making—Types, Purpose and Principles of Bed Making
4	Personal Hygiene and Care—Basic and Essential personal hygiene and Grooming procedures.
5	Support Care Recipient to meet the patient's needs; Nutrition & Basic Medication Management
6	Transferring, Lifting & Moving Techniques— Different types of repositioning bed; Manage mobility equipment; Assistive Devices; Walking Frame; Wheelchair and crutches.
7	Fall Prevention—Contributing Fall Risk Factors; Impacts of Falls; Fall Risk Measures.
8	Health and Safety—Fire Safety; First Aid Measures; Accident & Emergencies Responding and Reporting skills

Lecture rooms and course-related equipped rooms for practical sessions, at the JSS Academy, will be used for the delivery of the training programme.
