Training Programme on National Certificate Level 4 in Scaffolding

(MQA Approved)

NATIONAL CERTIFICATE LEVEL 4 IN SCAFFOLDING

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

This training programme has been designed to create awareness of the various types of scaffolds, their uses and construction; safety and management of various scaffolds used at the workplace; work at heights and identifying hazards that may be present on site in ensuring a safe working condition.

The course will provide knowledge of legal obligations contained within the Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Act 2022 and its Regulations and the construction standards required to ensure safe places of work. This course will also provide knowledge of the provision and management of first aid at the workplace.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants can expect to;

- (i) assess the site for the erection/ construction, reposition, use and dismantle a scaffolding safely,
- (ii) erect/construct, reposition, use and dismantle a scaffolding safely,
- (iii) work at height safely and
- (iv) manage and provide first aid at work places

PROGRAMME DELIVERY & METHODOLOGY

- (i) Programme delivery will be face-to-face lectures.
- (ii) Practical sessions for the erection, construction and dismantling of modular and tubular scaffoldings
- (iii) Visits at construction sites to carry out risk assessments.

DURATION

One year (two semesters)

PROGRAMME DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS

Lecture rooms and course-related equipped area for practical sessions, at the JSS Academy, will be used for the delivery of the training programme.

Participants are required to bring their own personal equipment (safety shoes, safety helmets, gloves and safety harness).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Learners having the National Certificate Level 3 in any trade in the construction industry (or alternative) with 1 year working experience in scaffolding works. Or National Certificate of Education (NCE) with 3 years working experience in scaffolding works or NQF Level 1 with 5 years working experience in scaffolding works. Or An alternative acceptable qualification at Level 3 of the NQF.
